Bullying vs. Conflict

As a school, this is one of the biggest parts of educating kids and parents. Often any conflict is labelled as bullying and we use these conflicts as a time to teach and educate. In our lives, we often have conflict with people and that is ok. It is important to teach kids the skills to deal with conflict. We use our WITS program to help teach kids how to deal with conflict and bullying.

Bullying is different from conflict. Conflict is a disagreement or argument in which both sides express their views. Bullying is negative behavior directed by someone exerting power and control over another person. Bullying is done with a goal to hurt, harm, or humiliate. This is a concern that home and school need to work together on and help students learn strategies to deal with conflict and bullying when they happen.
