- Principal Updates:

 in to have them assembled and ready to go.
 - It is started 6 week project

- Cross Country 34 runner (out of 45 students in gr. 3-5) amazing turnout. Students all demonstrated great sportsmanship. Scott and Jordan discussed expanding the race events to K-2 somehow. We will likely have to purchase more pinnies before next year, especially if we are going to open it for K-2.

- Student Vote students in Grades 3-5 did a student vote. They took it very seriously and made it official.

- School Improvement Plan we focused on Indigenous Education last year. We will
 continue to do Indigenous lessons but our main focus this year will be on Math.
 - Provincial Results results from last years assessment were not great. Our overall success rate was 36.4%. There are changes happening in the curriculum from the prioritized curriculum to the holistic curriculum which can be a factor. The assessment is also being done on the computer now, which may also be a factor. For this reason, we have chosen to focus on Math. We have already invited our Math lead out to meet with Scott, then the teachers to form a plan. We have a program that we use called 'RocketMath' that grades 3-5 use daily. We also use Mathletics as an online program.
